STORIES OF IMPACT

Manessah

I was born and raised by my granny in Compton while my dad went through rehab and my mom was on the streets. Emmanual and I first met in 6th grade, and we got together in 2017 shortly after my mom passed away.

When I found out I was pregnant my initial response was shock. I thought to myself, "You are so dumb. How could you? Why are you even thinking about keeping it?" I was still a kid myself and living with my grandma. I was looking for reasons to talk myself out of it, but I had a strong feeling that I was not supposed to terminate. I knew I loved him (my baby) before he was even here.

Emmanuel couldn't believe it as well. I thought he'd ask if I was going to keep the baby, but he never did. I grew respect for him at that time because he saw his responsibility in this and he stepped up.

I'm an esthetician, and while I was doing my friend's eyelashes I told her that I was pregnant. I didn't know where to go or who to see. She told me about Claris and how it's right here in Lynwood. I was skeptical at first, but she had three kids and was a part of Claris for all of her kids. I knew she wouldn't keep coming back to Claris if it wasn't great. I called in, and Monica (Claris staff member) was incredibly professional and comforting.


I'm most grateful for Lisa, the Claris midwife, and Claris' prenatal care program. I could always reach out to her, no matter the time of day, with questions or fears. She always got back to me with answers or articles to help assure me that there was nothing to be afraid of. I've never had that level of committed help before. She also referred me to my lactation consultant, my doula, and my pediatrician! When I faced postpartum depression, Lisa and I talked through a lot of my emotions. She helped ease my mind that even though I was about to become a young mother, I didn't have to be afraid. I could do this.

Claris isn't like a typical doctor's office - I've experienced nothing but love here. I want the Claris team to know that I couldn't have gotten through this pregnancy without them. My son King was born on May 19th. I'm excited to now join Claris' parenting program and give King everything I didn't have growing up -- most importantly the consistent presence of both a mother and a father. I will be telling others about the resources at Claris and passing that knowledge forward too.

STORIES OF IMPACT

Anisa

My story, which led me to Claris, began when I was only 16. I had gotten pregnant and I had an abortion. What a complicated and difficult decision for a teenager to make.

For a long time I tried to forget that it even happened and move on with life. This was not possible for me. I thought about my child every day for the next 6 years. I would pass the baby aisle in Target and start crying. I would feel guilty often and like God could not forgive me for what I had done. I would also always think of what my child would look like and important dates like the due date were extremely difficult for me mentally and emotionally. I did not know that this was actually very common for women who had experienced abortions. I went on to college and graduated finally feeling comfortable to reveal what was a secret to most of the people in my life. I felt a strong desire to help other women who had similar experiences not feel alone. I then learned about Claris and I wanted to volunteer. When I went for the volunteer orientation, I realized that I was actually the one who needed healing. I did not even know there were therapy groups and Bible studies related to having an abortion or miscarriage. It was definitely a Godsend! I was able to grieve my child in a healthy way. Understanding that my child is safe in heaven with God was one of the most freeing things ever. I now hold a very special place in my heart for Claris. I gave a similar testimony on video for the 2014 GALA because I believe so strongly that sharing my story will help to free others. Claris has always welcomed me with open arms and for that I am eternally grateful. Since going through the group with Claris, I have worked with Claris Health's program Reality Check telling my story and aiding the youth to make informed decisions about sex and healthy relationships. I also volunteered with other non-profit organizations catered to helping teens and women have strong self-esteem and heal from past traumas.

Since Claris had made such a big splash in my life, I am now making ripples in others' lives. Because I have healed, now others can get that same healing and not feel like they are alone in it like I did for so long. I want to talk to the person who is feeling alone right now watching me say this: I assure you, that you are not alone! If you or someone you know has had an abortion or a miscarriage and you need support, please reach out. I know this topic can bring up shame and other emotions for many men and women. However, after my experience with Claris being kind and nonjudgmental about my past and being able to walk in my freedom for years now, I can tell you it is worth it to get the support. You are worth it!

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

As of March 2021, people from all over the country have permanent access to Claris' unique services and model of care, giving pregnant women and families anywhere access to Claris' unique options education, community resources, and support from a trained virtual advocate.

•• Our first virtual appointment was with a woman who recently left an abusive relationship due to a disability. She was unable to travel to a Claris clinic. The new virtual appointments were the perfect solution for her as she needed help figuring out housing, disability support, prenatal care, and domestic violence support. Through her virtual visits at Claris, she was able to find the right solutions to meet her special needs, and she and her children are now in a safe living environment. 99

REFERRAL NETWORK

11 community partner agencies in LA County have been trained in the "Claris Way" approach to caring for women and families facina unintended pregnancies. With these agencies, Claris launched an official referral network of providers committed to serving pregnant women and families. This diverse network includes housing, employment, domestic violence, substance abuse agencies and more. There are plans to expand this training and referral network into other U.S. cities in 2022!

Perinatal and maternal mental health services are a high need in our members of the family.






2020 VIRTUAL GALA




